

Wheel Sizes

General

- Up to 77 ton capacity = 33" wheels
- 77 to 85 ton capacity = ? doesn't seem to have been addressed – maybe there is a reason for this!
- 85 to 100 ton capacity = 36" wheels
- Over 100 ton capacity = 38" wheels

Noted / Exceptions

- 28" instead of 33" wheels on low-level pig flat cars, low level autoracks and some depressed centre flat cars
- Certain <100 ton ACL hopper cars had 38" wheels, as did some nominal 100 ton unit coal cars which had 125 ton trucks
- Many modern articulated multi-well stack cars have 125 ton trucks with 38" wheels at the shared trucks.

Passenger Cars

- Generally passenger cars have 36" wheels
